### Secondary Phase Academy Uniform

Attached is a copy of our uniform guide. You will also find a copy of this is on our website. This guide outlines our expectation about uniform. Our policy states clearly that students are not allowed any jewellery or extreme hairstyles in school. Our uniform is our starting point for setting out our high standard, it is how we identify ourselves as an academy and I want all students, staff parents and carers to be proud of our academy – I certainly am.

It is essential that students return in the full, correct uniform in September. Non-uniform items such as tight trousers/leggings, short skirts, trainers, extreme hairstyles and piercings will not be allowed. Our focus in school remains on student's achievements and conversations about jewellery, extreme hairstyles and piercings detract our attention from this focus. As I have said before, our children are full of personality and individuality – this is what makes our school community so special. Like you, I want all our children to be confident individuals and this confidence stems from the inside.

As always, we ask for your support ensuring standards remain high. We do not ask that parents purchase Delta logoed uniform as this can be quite costly but we do ask that uniform items adhere to the attached guidance. We do sometimes have students returning in September with new piercings. Any students with piercings in September will be asked to remove them.

There are a few days when we are in school over the summer holidays, 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> September. If you would like to bring any uniform items you are unsure of for us to look at, we are happy to do this as we do not want you to end up with non-uniform items you are unable to return.

Uniform can be purchased direct from SPT Uniforms using the link on our website. Any uniform delivered to school will not incur a delivery charge.

# Uniform Guide

## Approved Uniform Items

### Shirts and Ties

Students are expected to wear a plain white long or short-sleeved shirt. The top button must be fastened. This must be worn with a Delta Academy clip on tie. Polo shirts are not acceptable.

### Blazers

A Black Delta Academy blazer must be worn during the school day unless permission is given by a member of staff to remove blazers.

### Jumpers

Students may wear a plain black V-neck jumper under their blazer.

### Trousers and Skirts

Full-length conventional trousers. Trousers must be formal and must not be tight fitting. Leggings, skinny, tight trousers must not be worn.

Girls may wear a black skirt that comes to the knees and is not tight fitting.

### Footwear

Plain black shoes with no logo or colour. No trainer style shoes, pumps or boots.

### Jewellery

A watch may be worn but smart watches are not allowed. No jewellery allowed.

### Make-up

No visible make-up allowed.

### PE Kit

- Delta polo shirt
- Delta PE shorts
- Black football sock

### Equipment

- A black pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Planner (the first one will be supplied)
- School bag large enough to hold A4 books
