Dear Parents, Carers and children,

As you know we are following the latest government announcements and we are in the process of opening up to have more children in school. We are using our through risk assessment to ensure that we gradually increase the numbers of children on site to enable us to maintain social distancing and prioritise the safety of all children and adults. This week has successfully seen 7 small groups of children now referred to as 'bubbles' access the school site and have a successful week. It has been lovely to have some of pupils back and we are desperate to have more children return to us as soon as it is safe.

We have reviewed our current provision and at this time, due to the increased uptake of places, we will remain open to only key worker and vulnerable children during the week commencing 8<sup>th</sup> June.

In addition to the above group, we plan to extend the provision to include those children from Year 6, whose parents have previously declared their intention to take a place via the parent letter dated / survey 15 May 2020. We will be contacting these parents next week to provide more detail on the provision we can offer. If you are a year 6 parent and have changed your mind and would / wouldn't not like your child to attend school, please can you contact us on 01302 742535.

We will continue to review our provision weekly and extend this to more children, if and when appropriate while adhering to the most recent guidance from the Government.

Thank you for your support during this very challenging time. We look forward to the day when we can welcome all of our children back to school.
